

Jelly Bean Game

You will need: A large bag of jelly beans.
Form groups of 6 young people. This is one family.



Label one member the father, one member the mother, one member 9 year old daughter, one member 7 year old son, one member 5 year old son, one member 3 year old daughter.

Each family member must eat at least 1 jelly bean every 10 mins to survive.

You earn jelly beans by working. The amount of education you have will determine the amount of jelly beans you will earn at work.

No Education – boys earn 2 jelly beans, girls earn 1 jelly bean.
Educated until age 11 – boys earn 4 jelly beans, girls earn 2 jelly beans.
Educated until age 15 – boys earn 6 jelly beans, girls earn 3 jelly beans.
Educated until age 18 – boys earn 20 jelly beans, girls earn 8 jelly beans.

You cannot work if you are under the age of 5 or at school or looking after the house and children. You start school at age 5 and you cannot do school and any other jobs.

Start

Father educated until age 11

Mother educated until age 11

All children have been educated from the age of 5.


One family member must look after the house and children.

Decide as a family who goes to work and who goes to school.

After 1 year (10 gaming minutes)

Receive your jelly bean wages. Any family members who don't have a jelly bean die. Any extra jelly beans can either be saved or eaten.

All family members are 1 year older.



One family member must look after the house and children
Decide as a family who goes to work and who goes to school.
Continue playing the game. Every 10 mins each family getting the appropriate wages and getting a year older.

During the game you can bring in the following challenges:
The option to sell any boys over age 8 to a rebel army for 25 jelly beans.
The local well has Cholera in it. Either choose one family member to spend half their time going to fetch water therefore getting $\frac{1}{2}$ wages or the youngest family member will die from Cholera.

All girls are married when they are 13 and are therefore not part of your family any more.

After the age of 11 you have to pay 1 jelly bean to the school for each child in education.

A charity opens a night school, it can only take one child per family but that child can also work during the day.

Girls who go into prostitution get 3 jelly beans no matter the level of education but risk being killed or getting pregnant.

One of the children is injured and cannot work for 1 year.

The mother gives birth to a new child.

One child is sponsored through a charity and automatically gets their Jelly Bean as long as they go to school.
