### The Alphabet Game

Pick a topic and starting with 'A', think of a word beginning with that letter. The next person has to think of a word with the last letter of the word they chose. For Example, if the topic was animals and they said 'anteater', the next person has to think of an animal beginning with 'R'. Some topic ideas are: animals, celebrities, TV programmes, countries, girls or boys names.

### Car Karaoke

Put the car radio on. When a song comes on, list to the first few words then switch the radio off. Everyone in the car has to join in and sing the rest of the song. Flick the radio back on after a little while to see if you're keeping up with the lyrics.

### Silly Stories

Take it in turn to tell a piece of a story. For example, the first person says 'Little Billy went on holiday and when he opened his suitcase he found...' and the next person says 'a baby kangaroo...' and so on. You'll be amazed how silly the stories can get.

### And We There Yet?

Print out a map of your route for each of the kids from the RAC Route Planner. As you pass land marks, places or road signs on your journey, point them out and they can mark them off on the map. That way they know how far they have left and don't spend the journey asking if you're nearly there yet.

### Name That Tune

Take it in turns to sing a few words from a song. Everyone has to guess the title of the song and the artist.
